Countries have committed to ensuring inclusive and equitable quality education by 2030 in line with the Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG 4). Established in 2002, the GEM Report is an editorially independent report, hosted and published by UNESCO to monitor and report on the progress and implementation of SDG 4 / Education 2030. Each edition of the report is dedicated to a highly topical subject. In 2023, the report sheds light on the opportunities and risks of Education Technology.

EdTech generates passionate debates around questions such as: does EdTech promote equality; or does it exacerbate inequality – between and within countries? How can education systems provide the skills required to keep up with technological progress while protecting learners from the risks of technology? How can EdTech speed up progress toward reaching SDG 4 targets by 2023, in Switzerland and in the Global South?

The Swiss Launch of the [GEM Report 2023](#) is the opportunity to learn about progress made towards SDG 4 at the global level and understand international trends and debates related to EdTech.
